

Notes on filling out the checklist

1. Authors are strongly advised to have the manuscript proofread by a native English speaker or a person who is well-experienced in writing English manuscripts.
2. All authors must agree to submission of the manuscript and transfer of their respective copyrights to KJMS.
3. The submission must be original, unpublished work that is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
4. When reporting on experiments on animals, authors must indicate in “Materials and methods” in the manuscript itself whether all institutional and national guidelines for the care and use of laboratory animals were followed.

EX: 1. This study was approved by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (Permission number:_____) and carried out according to Kobe University Animal Experimentation Regulations.

2. This study was approved by the Committee for Safe Handling of Living Modified Organisms of Kobe University (Permission number:_____) and carried out according to the guidelines of the committee.

5. When reporting on experiments on human subjects, authors must indicate in the manuscript whether the procedures followed were in accordance with ethical standards of all institutional and national guidelines.

EX: 1. All procedures used in this research were approved by the Ethics Committee of ABC University Hospital.

2. This study has been approved by the Research Ethics Committee (or Institutional Review Board) of DEF University.

6. Authors must state that patients’ consent was obtained when reporting on experiments on human subjects, or provide case reports (where needed).

EX: Written informed consent was obtained from the patient for publication of this case report and accompanying images.

7. Authors are expected to disclose any potential conflicts of interest. Authors must state in “Acknowledgments” whether there were any payments or services received from a third party for any aspect of the research submitted.

EX: 1. This research is supported by grants from the JKL (JK1234). J.S. is supported by a doctoral scholarship from the XYZ.

2. None of the authors has any conflict of interest or any financial ties to disclose.
