- 1. How and where to attend online lectures (same as before)

 - ②Your division's laboratory/research facility with internet connection only if approved by your professor.
 - ③Your division's laboratory/research facility with internet connection only if you are working as a medical professional at Kobe University Hospital or at Graduate School of Medicine.
 - ④Your work place with internet connection only if your company/hospital/institution allows you to take online lectures there.

3. Attendance Check

Starting Academic Year 2020, Kobe University has set a new grading rule; grading or giving credits should not be solely based on attendance but <u>on multiple evaluation methods</u>. In compliance with this, students are now asked to submit a short report for each lecture.

- Students must write a short report (200 words in Japanese, 150 words in English, approximately) and email it to a designated email address after attending a lecture.
