I participated in this seminar because I know that this speaker give good lecture. I learned about disasters and emergencies, case studies of disasters, and urbanization and climate change in this seminar. In disasters and emergencies, I learned about Asia Pacific four times more likely to be affected by natural disasters than in Africa, and 25 times more likely than in Europe or North America. In addition, in Western Pacific Region countries, I learned about 2% increase in the number of disasters in 2002-2006 vs. 2007-2011. In case studies of disasters, I learned about findings and gaps of Great East Japan Earthquake, Bangkok Floods, and Haiti Earthquake and so on.

In urbanization, I learned about urban health is recognized as a global public health issue. I surprised that Tokyo is the most populous urban area in the world by 2025. Therefore, I think very important that we do not only study a Health Emergencies in Japan, but also we study a worldwide Health Emergencies.
