
Current situation of drug users (as of Jan. 15. 2017) and strategies for their reintegration in Muntinlupa City



What is Mamamayan at Pamilya Laban sa Droga (MAPALAD) program?

Program name meaning: Citizens and Families Against Drugs in Tagalog.

Objective: To reintegrate into the community the persons who have fallen victims of illegal drug abuse.

Implemented by: DAPCO (as leading agency), Social Service Division, City Health Office.

Supported by: 5 agencies listed in the above figure,

+ 9 Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Councils, Muntinlupa Philippine National Police.

Partnership with: The Association of Born Again Christians of Muntinlupa,

International Evangelical Church of Alabang, and Christ's Commission Fellowship.

Program overview:

One-Stop Shop for screening and processing (2 waves for each barangay in 2016)

The aims is to determine the appropriate intervention to be given to each surrenderee. It includes 5 steps:

- 1) Reception by BADAC, 2) Screening by Social Services Division, 3) Assessment by Social Services Division,
- 4) Processing by DAPCO, 5) Drug Dependency Examination by City Health Office.

Based on Substance Use Severity Index (11 criteria for diagnosis of substance use disorder in DSM5), the surrenderees are divided into 3 groups: Mild, Moderate, and Severe dependence.

For Surrenderees with Mild & Moderate Dependence

■ At least 3-month participation in the modality groups. There are 3 different modalities:

12 steps of Narcotic Anonymous	Drug users	Trained barangay facilitators
8 principles of Celebrate Recovery	Drug users	Trained barangay facilitators
Simula ng pag-asa (Beginning of hope)	Drug users & Families	Volunteers of Christ's Commission Fellowship

■ 5 different types of financial & vocational assistances are offered (See the above figure).

For Surrenderees with Severe Dependence

■ Referral to rehabilitation centers. The fees (pesos) are as follows:

Туре	In-patient: 7 months – 1 year	Follow-up out-patient
National centers in Taguig/ Tagaytay	4,000 for entry +4,000 per month (750 for the poor)	1,000 per month
Private centers	15,000 – 54,000 per month	

■ For those who can not afford the rehabilitation, the cost can be shared by the Barangay. (Crisis Assistance for the Rehabilitation of Indigent Drug Dependent (CARIDD))
